Georgia Marie (Faye) Clark Feronberg was born on September 11, 1940 in Matagorda, Texas. She was the fourth child of the late Reverend George Edward Clark Jr. and Myrtle Patterson Clark of Matagorda Texas. Her early education began in Bay City, Texas and continued in Houston, Texas.

She married Charles Feronberg in March 1967; there were no children born to that union. Later she relocated to San Francisco, California and then moved to Boston, Massachusetts.

Georgia's (Faye) religious education began in Texas, where she was active in the church in many areas which had extended to her final church home at Metropolitan Baptist Church. She served faithfully on the Senior Usher Board as well as the Church Clerk for eighteen years. Faye remained in that position until her health caused her to resign. She truly loved her church and her church family.

She began working at Northeastern University in July 1981 where she worked in an administrative capacity. While working at Northeastern, she furthered her education by receiving certifications in Human Resource Management in 1986 and an Associate Degree in Science in 1999. She remained on the staff of the university for twenty years retiring in September, 2001.

Faye was predeceased by her parents and siblings. Left to mourn her passing is her small biological family consisting of cousins, nieces, nephews, mostly residing in Texas. Also mourning her loss are her many former co-workers, her church family, as well as many close friends to name just a few: Yvonne Jackson, Mary Wilson, and Erica Preze who passed in March, 2012; and the one and only Buttercup (Smile).
